Official UK Launch Price (SIM-free / Outright Purchase)

When Apple unveiled the iPhone 17 Pro, the company confirmed that the model would start at £1,099 in the UK for the base storage version (256 GB) with the three standard finishes: Cosmic Orange, Deep Blue and Silver.

Because Apple dropped the 128 GB variant this year, the 256 GB base model now carries a higher price than many past iPhones. Higher storage tiers (512 GB, 1 TB) will naturally push the price up further, although Apple does not publish a single universal price — it varies by configuration.

In short: if you want a "SIM-free and un-locked" iPhone 17 Pro in the UK, budget around £1,099 as the starting point.

Monthly Contract & Pay-Monthly Deals

Not everyone prefers to pay the full price upfront. In the UK you can also get iPhone 17 Pro via mobile carrier deals and financing plans. The actual monthly cost depends on your data plan, contract length, and any upfront payment required.

For example:

- Some plans start from around £42-£44 per month with a small upfront fee (for example £12), making the device more affordable spread over 36 months.
- Other providers list prices around £56-£60 per month (before VAT or inclusive of plan data) under certain business or unlimited-data contracts.
- Depending on deal terms (data allowance, call minutes, texts, trade-in, contract length), the "all-in" cost over 2–3 years can come close to or exceed the SIM-free upfront price but payment is spread out.

If you care more about cash flow or prefer predictable monthly payments over upfront cost, a contract deal may suit you best. Just be sure to check the data plan, contract term, and whether the monthly cost includes the device or only the network plan.

Why UK Price Is Higher Than in Some Markets

There are a few reasons the iPhone 17 Pro costs more in the UK than in some other countries (especially where prices are quoted in USD):

- Base storage is now 256 GB rather than 128 GB so even the "entry-level" model is more expensive than in past years.
- Higher import costs, taxes, and regional pricing differences tend to push UK retail pricing upwards. Apple sets different pricing for different regions accordingly.
- Advanced hardware powerful new chip (A19 Pro), upgraded camera system, durable build materials means production costs are higher, which reflects in retail price.

Should You Buy Now or Wait for Deals / Refurbished Units?

Buying brand-new from Apple guarantees you the latest hardware, full warranty, and software support. However, if price is a concern, several UK retailers and carriers sometimes offer iPhone 17 Pro on deals or with trade-in discounts.

For instance, some contract plans spread the cost over 36 months at a lower monthly rate. That may work well if you don't want to pay £1,099 at once. Alternatively, refurbished or trade-in models (offered by some retailers shortly after launch) may yield savings — but take care to verify condition and warranty terms.
